

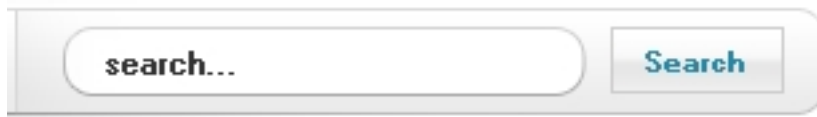

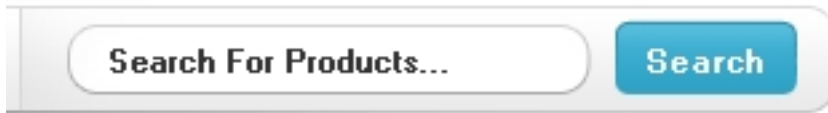

- This position was only designed for search modules, not content.

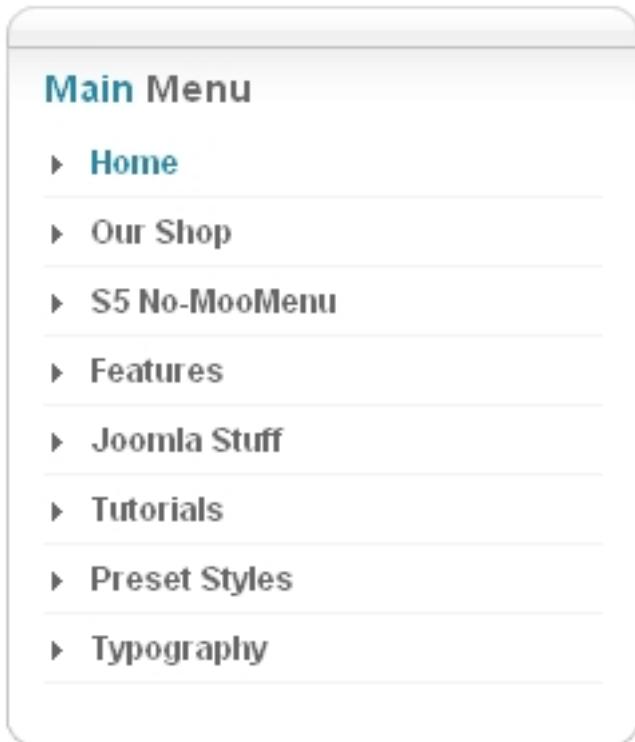

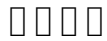
