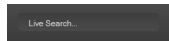


How To Setup the Search Box and Menus

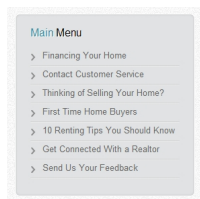
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1. Search Setup



- Publish the default Joomla search module or S5 Live Search module to the 'search' position.
- Set the width of the search to 400, margin top to 2, margin left to -30 and lastly popup margin left to -183 in the module's backend.
- This position was only designed for search modules, not content.

2. Column Menu Setup




- Publish any menu module to the main body module positions on your site.
- There should be no menu style suffixes applied under advanced parameters.
- The menu style should be set to list.
- You may assign any of this template's module class suffixes.

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3. Bottom Menu Setup
